The second floor offices and conference room have been framed out. More of the sprawling first floor is being readied for exhibit and studio use. A stone facade on the alleyway wall enhanced with modern lighting will enable attractive access to the rear of the building. And opening in September, the Museum will host a cafe run by the culinary students from BOCES.
